Did you know that on June 6 around half a million people, in nearly 550 places across the United States, protested in support of the Black Lives Matter movement?

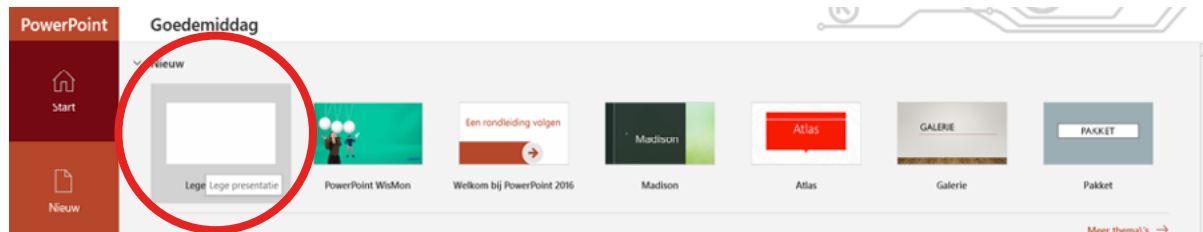

In order to gain more insight into the development of the BLM movement, you are going to create a timeline using PowerPoint. Work together with your classmate and follow the steps below.

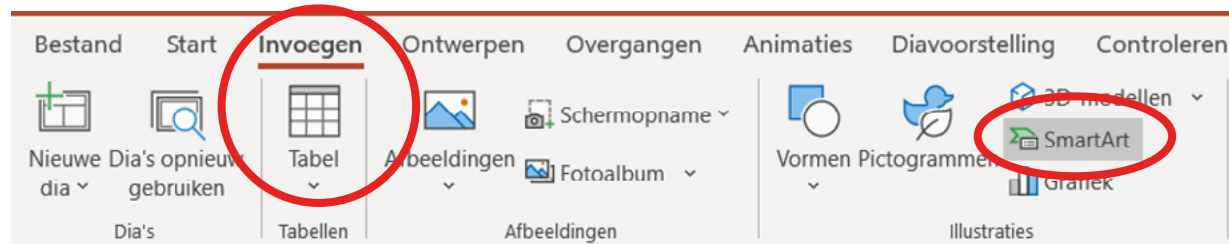
Step 1

Open PowerPoint and open an empty presentation.



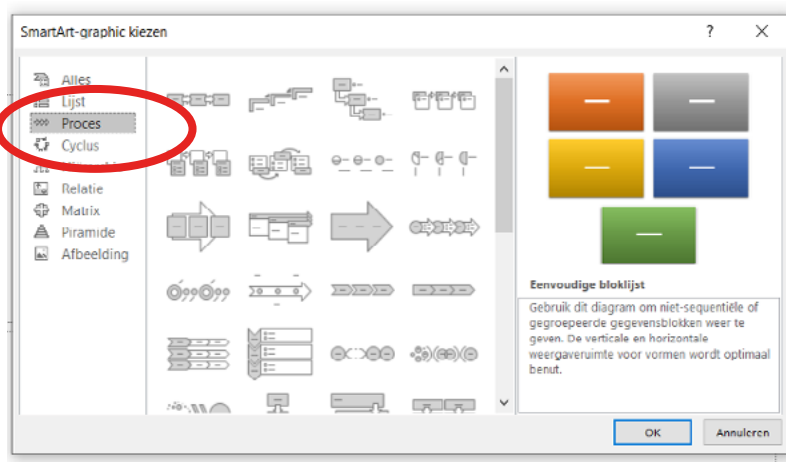
Step 2

Go to <Invoegen> <SmartArt>.



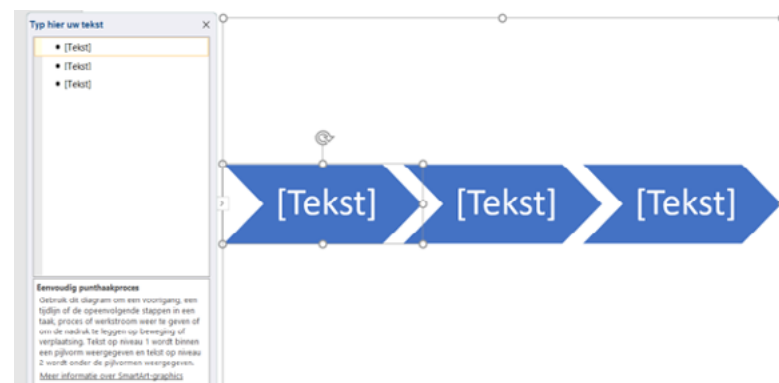
Step 3

In the popup window go to <Proces>, choose a diagram that you find suitable for a timeline and click on <OK>.



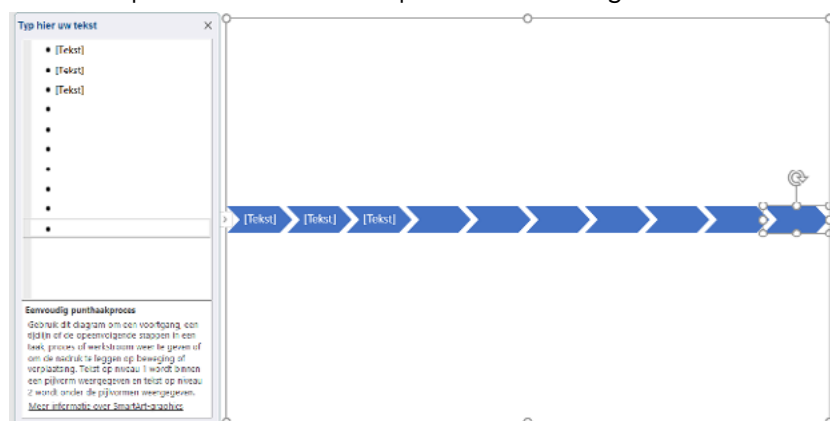
Step 4

Click on the little arrow in the middle of the left edge of the rectangle around the diagram in order to open the text editor.



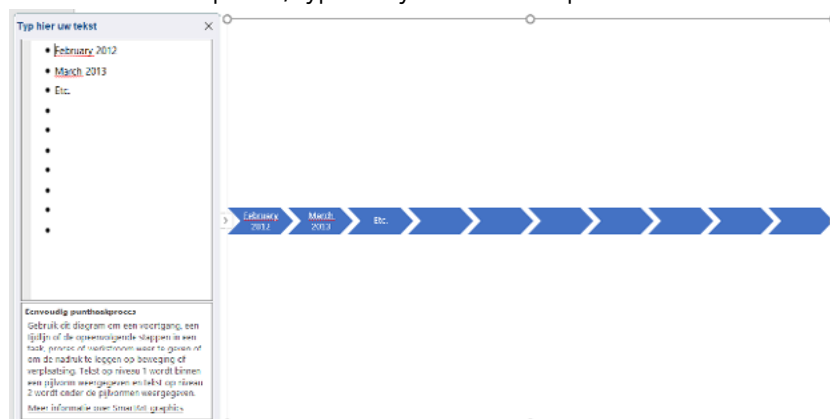
Step 5

The bullet points indicate the components of the diagram. Increase the number of components to ten.



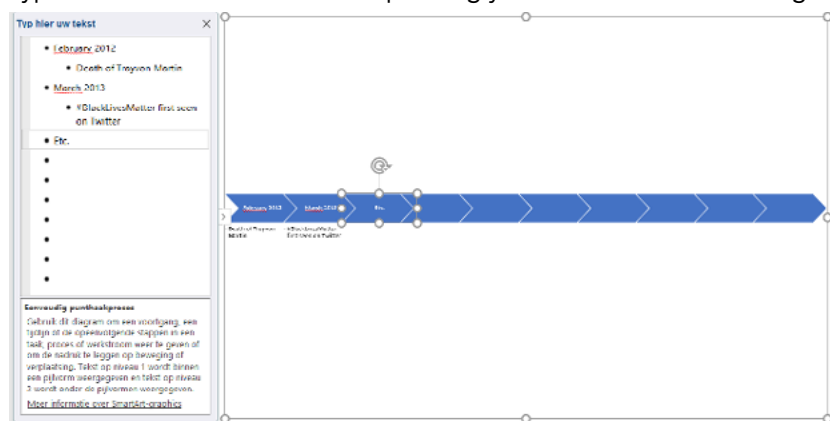
Step 6

Behind the bullet points, type the years of the important events from exercise 1.

Type the events below the corresponding year. Create an indent using 'tab'.
