DID YOU KNOW?

The 'Choose Your Own Adventure' book series was one of the most popular children's series during the 1980s and 1990s, selling more than 250 million copies between 1979 and 1998.

In this exercise, you are going to make your own interactive story: a story in which the storyline is not predetermined. The reader makes choices that determine the main character's actions and the plot's outcome.

Then follow the steps below and create your own interactive story!

Step 1

What is your story going to be about?

Step 2

What is the purpose of your story, what do you want to achieve?

Step 3

Write out the rough main plot of your story. Write the different scenes in the boxes below.

Write out the whole story in a branching tree. Choose one of the following structures: branching structure or a folding structure.




Figure 1 Branching structure





Figure 2 Folding structure

After reading the tip, you can go to <http://twinery.org/2> and make a new story via the green button '+ story'.




Give your story a name and hit 'enter' or press '+add'.


